As S Pollard was injured, Stewards permitted the following riding substitutions:

Race 7	The Inflamer – A Layt

RACE 1: JAMES MUNRO AO MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 63 HANDICAP 1280M

Dutchess Moshe – Change of tactics: to be more forward; settled off pace.

Loyal Toast – Began awkwardly. Briefly held up making the home turn. Lay out under pressure in the straight.

Jar of Hearts – App C Gravener was reminded of her obligation to ride her mounts out fully to the line.

Zarina's Gold – Rider K Adams reported her mount never travelled at any stage and was not comfortable on the synthetic surface. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare which was beaten 35L revealed no abnormalities. Trainer M Sparrow was advised that the mare must barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing again.

Dylan's Deeva – Raced keenly in the middle stages. Near the 900m was steadied off the heels of Jar of Hearts (App C Gravener) which shifted in when not quite clear. App Gravener was advised to exercise more care.

RACE 2: MONARO WINDOWS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP**1900M**

Swindlers Miss – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

Tip Jar – Slow to begin.

RACE 3: RIVERVIEW GROUP MAIDEN HANDICAP**1080M**

Reason To Smile – Near the 200m shifted to the inside of the heels of Miss Breffni to continue into clear running.

Filly Collins – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer Ms M Rae was advised that a warning would be recorded against the filly which was beaten 21(L).

Embezzlement – Raced wide throughout.

Portare – When the pace slackened near the 800m the filly was steadied off heels. When questioned J Ford stated that this mount never travelled well at any stage and was inclined to lay in over the final 200m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Lady Patrika – Slow to begin. Near the 100m was bumped by Portare which laid in.

Star For Effort – Began awkwardly.

Tiffoni – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

RACE 4: BID WILLIAMS MAIDEN HANDICAP**1750M**

Water Line – Slow to begin. When questioned App P Scorse stated he was instructed to ride his mount quietly with cover. He added that after his mount was inclined to race keenly in the middle stages, he was then obliged to commence a wide run making the home turn when runners in advance of him failed to quicken. He added his mount responded fairly under pressure in the circumstances where it was able to make up some ground late in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Experienced – Raced keenly in the middle stages. Near the 900m became awkward on the heels of Bingi Striker and shifted out. The gelding was then obliged to race wide thereafter. Lay in under pressure in the straight and proved difficult to ride out in the straight.

Money Crazy – Bumped on jumping by Stately Boy which began awkwardly.

Stately Boy – Began awkwardly and bumped Money Crazy. Subsequent to the event the club's veterinary officer attended to the gelding which was found to have debris in one eye that required treatment.

Warrawillah – Change of tactics; to be ridden positively and attempt to lead – led in the early stages, took trail from 1000m.

Casino's Jewels – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Bridges – Began awkwardly.

Consoling – Change of tactics; to be ridden closer to the speed; settled handy.

RACE 5: HUON CLASS 1 HANDICAP

Irish Lucy – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the filly racing further back today, J Penza advised whilst there are appeared to be genuine early speed in this event, he was instructed to take up a forward position and expected to be in the first four. He added when his mount began awkwardly, it then failed to muster speed and for this reason he elected to ease and take up a trailing position. J Penza added in his opinion, his mount was not entirely comfortable on the synthetic surface.

Lansala – Began awkwardly.

Living Doll – Began awkwardly.

Paradiso Girl – Slow to begin.

Tay Tay Taylor – Lay out in the middle stages. Making the home turn was briefly tightened between Silver Comet and Lansala which lay out.

RACE 6: MOBY DICK'S TAVERN MAIDEN HANDICAP

Buddyiz – Slow to begin.

Beat The Charge – As J Devrimol was indisposed due to illness, Stewards permitted Ms J Taylor to be substituted as the rider of the gelding.

Treasure The Love – Raced wide throughout.

Dangan Ressha – Raced wide throughout.

Future Time – Slow to begin (2L). When questioned App A Sweeney stated after missing the start his mount then failed to muster any speed and was under pressure throughout the event. He added that whilst the horse sprinted well first up on the 8th June 2018 on this same track, the horse has not previously performed well second up and in his opinion would benefit stepping up in distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Ligny – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Doomsday Command – Change of tactics; to be more forward – settled handy. Rider S Guymer reported his mount was never comfortable on the synthetic surface at any stage and when his mount was not responding, he eased it down in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 7: TAB FEDERAL BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP

Snip The Mo – A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding which hung in under pressure in the straight revealed no abnormalities.

Lulu Raez – Lay in under pressure in the straight.

Exaggerate – App J Hughes was reminded of her obligation to ride her mounts out fully to the line.

The Inflamer – Slow to begin.

Mandee – Bumped shortly after the start by Torchbearer that shifted out.

Stephan – Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

Ticked Off – Raced keenly in the middle stages. Restrained from heels passing the 900m.

Myristica – Rider C Reith reported his mount was inclined to hang out throughout the event and was disappointing in its failure to run on. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Bonsley – Shortly after straightening became awkward on the heels of Snip The Mo and shifted in to continue into clear running.

Torchbearer – App J Hughes (Exaggerate) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding (AR137(a)) in that she permitted her mount to shift in near the 900m when not clear of Torchbearer which lost its running and was checked, and also Ticked Off which lost its running and was restrained. App J Hughes permit to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence on Sunday 1st July 2018 and to expire on Wednesday 4th July 2018 on which day she may ride. In assessing penalty the Stewards considered App J Hughes' previous good record in respect to careless riding.

RACE 8: QUEANBEYAN RIVERSIDE TOURIST PARK BENCHMARK 55 HANDICAP

Tinybella – Raced wide throughout.

Mr Fox – On jumping was bumped by Brimstone.

Cash Strapped – Bumped on jumping by Alpine King.

Alpine King – Bumped on jumping. Raced wide throughout.

Alastriona – Raced keenly in the early stages.

Quite Magical – Dipped on jumping and shortly after was bumped by Zuzzudio. Raced keenly in the middle stages. Rider S Guymmer reported his mount travelled well but could offer no explanation for its failure to run on in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

SWAB SAMPLES:

Swab samples were taken from all winners.

Whip Use Summary:

Stewards noted the following riders exceeded the permitted strikes of the whip prior to the 100m under AR137A(5)(a)(ii). Bearing in mind the totality of whip use, no action was taken.
