Track: Soft (7), upgraded to a Soft (6) at 11:33pm.

Rail: Out 6m

As B Loy was found to be overweight, Stewards permitted the following riding substitutions:

Race 1	Brandy Stinger – App P Scorse (2kg allowance) (No other senior rider available)
Race 3	Who Da Witness – B Ward
Race 7	Bramwell – B Ward

At a subsequent inquiry B Loy was fined the sum of \$400 under AR120(b).

As M Travers was unavailable due to injury, Stewards permitted the following riding substitutions:

Race 2	Beyond Beautiful – M Cahill
Race 3	Chief Of Arlington – S Miller
Race 4	Coogee Beach – Initially E Kacmaz but replaced due to misunderstanding when unable to make the weight and replaced by A Banks.
Race 5	Dripping Carats – S Miller
Race 6	Yawkey Bay – E Kacmaz
Race 7	Hangin'With Willy – E Kacmaz
Race 8	Café Terrace – E Kacmaz

RACE 1: CASINO CANBERRA MAIDEN PLATE

1400M

Greyfell – Slow to begin and hampered shortly after.

Brandy Stinger – S Miller (Airport) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that near the 1000m he permitted his mount to shift in when not clear of Brandy Stinger which was inclined to over-race resulting in that runner having to be restrained out across the heels of that runner. S Miller's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence on Friday 10 November 2017 and to expire on Friday 17 November 2017, on which day he may ride.

Moonlight Duchess – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Following the running of this event the track was upgraded to a Soft (6) at 11:33pm to be made retrospective to include this race.

RACE 2: ELVIN GROUP CLASS 3 HANDICAP**1600M**

Kiss In The Dark – Change of tactics: To be ridden more forward; led.

Loyal Toast – Slow to begin.

Duvet – Slow to begin. Held up in the early part of the straight and passing the 150m was disappointed for a run to the inside of Kiss In The Dark and had to be eased and shifted out to obtain clear running.

Grasp – Slow to begin.

RACE 3: SEARS WORKWEAR MAIDEN HANDICAP**1200M**

Mastery – Trainer Mr P Facoor was fined the sum of \$50 under LR35 for the late declaration of A Banks as the rider of the gelding.

Metralia – Bounded on jumping.

Explosive Missile – Jumped in at the start. Over the concluding stages was inconvenienced when taken out by Ethnicity (App C MacFarlane) which shifted out. App Ms C MacFarlane was advised to exercise more care. When questioned, rider app R Dolan stated that he was instructed to take up a forward position however from his wide gate he was unable to find a position and as a consequence his mount was obliged to race wide throughout.

Alpine King – Passing the 700m was eased from the heels of Who Da Witness (B Ward) which shifted in when not clear. B Ward was advised to exercise more care.

RACE 4: CAPITAL HOTEL GROUP CLASS 2 HANDICAP**1000M**

Time Of Her Life – Bounded on jumping. Raced wide throughout.

Snip The Mo – Slow to begin.

Seduction – Over-raced with its head up in the early and middle stages.

RACE 5: NCG SERVICES CLASS 1 & MAIDEN PLATE**2000M**

Confess And Avoid – Began awkwardly. After the 100m when shifting inwards, was hampered by Dripping Carats (S Miller) which shifted out simultaneously. In the circumstances S Miller was advised to exercise more care.

Kadoma Man – Raced wide in the early in the early and middle stages.

Joe's Joy – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Passing the 300m when attempting to improve to the outside of Cool Dude, was hampered by that runner which hung out.

Cool Dude – Hung out rounding the home turn.

Le Scare Blur – Was taken wider rounding the home turn by Cool Dude which hung out.

Cheung Fun – Was taken wider rounding the home turn by Le Sacre Blur which was taken out by Cool Dude which hung out.

Dripping Carats – Correct weight was delayed at the request of trainer Mr M Smith to enable him to view a replay of the race to ascertain whether there were grounds to lodge an objection against the

second placegetter Sans Cliché for alleged interference over the concluding stages. After viewing the vision and when satisfied that there were not sufficient grounds, no objection was lodged and correct weight was declared when Stewards were of the same view. B Loy (Sans Cliche) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that over the concluding stages he permitted his mount to shift out under riding when not clear of Dripping Carats which was hampered and had to be restrained. B Loy's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence at the expiration of a careless riding suspension incurred at Wagga on 3 November 2017 and therefore to commence on Saturday 18 November 2017 and to expire on Sunday 26 November 2017, on which day he may ride.

RACE 6: TAB.COM.AU BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP 1200M

Big Albert – Slow to begin.

Fire And Flood – Near the 800m was checked when badly crowded between Supreme Lad and Time In Motion which was taken out by Black Dragon which after initially being straightened by its rider to avoid causing interference to Addchan which was positioned back to his inside, then ran out and away from Ribs which shifted out after its rider A Banks found himself inside the line of the running rail linking up with the course proper and shifted out. In all the circumstances, A Banks was spoken to and advised that he must be more alert in avoiding getting inside the line of the running rail joining up with the course proper.

Supreme Lad – Pulled hard in the middle stages.

RACE 7: PAUT IT BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP 1400M

Prima Stella – Slow to begin.

Hangin' With Willy – Pulled hard in the early and middle stages. Upon return to scale it was reported that the saddle had slipped back during the event.

RACE 8: CAPITAL TROPHIES & SPORTSWEAR HANDICAP 1300M

Already Leica – Due to a misunderstanding, app C MacFarlane was declared as the rider of the mare when she held a prior booking on Mr Fox in this race. Stewards permitted B Loy to be substituted as the rider of Already Leica.

Tip Jar – Slow to begin.

Café Terrace – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

You're Kidding Me – Slow to begin.

Zambada – Slow to begin.

Mr Fox – Slow to begin.

Dylan's Deeva – Over-raced badly in the early and middle stages. Passing the 1150m was restrained from the heels of Oh What A Thief (A Banks) which shifted in when not clear. A Banks was reprimanded (AR137(a)).

Diamond Charlie – E Kacmaz (Café Terrace) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that passing the 1100m he permitted his mount to shift in when not clear of Diamond Charlie contributing to that runner being checked. E Kacmaz's licence to ride in races was

suspended for a period to commence immediately and to expire on Sunday 12 November 2017, on which day he may ride. Held up in the early part of the straight.

Summary of whip use

Stewards noted the following rider exceeded the permitted strikes of the whip prior to the 100m under AR137A(5)(a)(ii):
