RACE 1: YOUR LOCAL BUSINESS ADVISOR 2YO HANDICAP

1200M

Able Touch—Slow to begin.

Mystique Beauty—Contacted shortly after the start by *Sensacova*, which shifted in. Overraced in the middle stages of the event and passing the 700 metres had to be restrained from the heels of *Running Broke*.

Polson—Change of tactics: to be ridden quieter; settled mid-field. When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of the filly, rider B Ward stated that in his view his mount did not handle the heavy (10) track conditions at any stage. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in its near foreleg. Trainer Mr N. Olive advised that the filly would now be sent for a spell.

Sensacova—Lost its near hind plate on jumping.

RACE 2: YOUR CANBERRA CLUBS MAIDEN PLATE

1000M

Bull Bailey—Began awkwardly and lost ground.

Mister Snitzel—Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously with its head up passing the 600 metres and passing the 500 metres got its head up and overreacted after being restrained when racing in restricted room between *La Superba* and *Run Hoff Run*. Held up rounding the home turn.

Noble Monarch—Slow to begin.

Enmity—A pre-race veterinary examination of the mare behind the barriers cleared the mare fit to start. When questioned regarding the performance of the mare, rider S. Guymer stated that he was instructed to lead in accordance with the mare's racing pattern. He added however when *Yasnat* showed superior speed in the early stages he was obliged to take a trailing position behind that runner. He added that his mount then did not travel comfortably in the middle stages of the event, did not run on under pressure in the straight, and in his view was disadvantaged when not able to lead today. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare revealed no abnormality.

Quiano Queen—On jumping was bumped by *Admire Gratzi*, which shifted out. Obligated to race very wide throughout.

Thurso—Slow to begin.

Admire Gratzi—Began awkwardly, shifted out and made contact with *Quiano Queen*.

RACE 3: VAUGHAN WELCH & BRETT MORRISSEY CLASS 2 HCP (SCALED +1.0KG) 1600M

Southern Gamble—When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of the gelding, rider A. Layt stated that his mount travelled well during the early and middle stages, however shortly after being placed under pressure passing the 600 metres his mount dipped on several occasions and then did not respond to his riding in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding revealed no abnormalities.

Chaquinta—Slow to begin. App. B. McDougall was fined the sum of \$200 under AR137A (5) (a) (ii) for using his whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres, two more than is permitted under the rule.

RACE 4: HAHN SUPER DRY BENCHMARK 65 HANDICAP 1400M

The Big Rig—Became held up after the 200 metres and had to be angled out to attempt to find cover.

Mazurka—When questioned in regard to the disappointing performance of the filly, rider M. Cahill stated that when *Auckland Beauty* showed intent to lead he was obliged to take up a position trailing that mare. He added that while the filly travelled well until the home turn, it did not respond to his riding in the straight and was disappointing in the way in which it finished off the race. He further added that the filly may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination of the filly did not reveal any abnormalities. Trainer Mr J. Kirkup advised that the filly would now be sent for a spell.

RACE 5: ELITE SOUND & LIGHTING CLASS 1 HANDICAP 1200M

Queen Tara—Slow to begin.

Snipps Parade—App. B. McDougall was fined the sum of \$200 under AR137A (5) (a) (ii) for using his whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres, two more than is permitted under the rule.

Barksdale—A little slow to begin.

RACE 6: TAB MAIDEN PLATE 1400M

Lethal Dream—A pre-race veterinary examination of the gelding, which sustained an abrasion to the inside of its near hind leg during transportation today, passed the gelding fit to start. Hung badly for some distance passing the 1000 metres. Shifted outwards under pressure in the straight.

Oscar Time—Began awkwardly and shifted in. After the 1000 metres shifted in and made slight contact with *Zardabba* and shortly after had to be restrained when crowded between *Zardabba* and *Lethal Dream*, which hung in badly despite the efforts of its rider. Approaching the 150 metres was eased when crowded between *Addchan* and *Fairy Shadow*, both of which shifted ground.

Out Of The Night—Began awkwardly resulting in its rider App. R. Hunt becoming unbalanced. Passing the 1000 metres had to be restrained when crowded for room between *Honour Your Offer* and *Zardabba*, which shifted in after being brushed by *Oscar Time*, which shifted in slightly.

Trying—After the 500 metres, when attempting a narrow run between *Honour Your Offer*, which was weakening quickly and *Out Of The Night*, was contacted by *Out Of The Night* (App. R. Hunt) when that runner shifted in slightly. App. Hunt was advised to exercise more care in similar circumstances. Rider M. Cahill pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A (5) (a) (ii) in that he did use his whip on twelve occasions prior to the 100 metres, seven more than is permitted under the rule. M. Cahill's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period to commence on Sunday 12 June 2016 and to expire on Sunday 26 June 2016, on which day he may ride. M. Cahill was further issued with a reprimand under AR137A (5) (a) (i) in that nine of those strikes were successive.

Zardabba—When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding, rider S. Miller reported that his mount travelled reasonably well during the early and middle stages, however hung in badly in the straight and was nevertheless disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding revealed no abnormalities.

Addchan—Slow to begin and hampered shortly after by *Oscar Time*, which began awkwardly and shifted in. Passing the 500 metres became held up on the heels of *Trying* and when awkwardly positioned on the heels of that runner and to the inside of *Fairy Shadow* had to be checked from the heels of *Trying*.

Fairy Shadow—Dipped passing the 700 metres.

Kim's Halo—A pre-race veterinary examination of the mare, which sustained an abrasion to its right hind canon en route to the course, passed the mare fit to start.

RACE 7: WILD OATS BENCHMARK 65 HANDICAP 1000M

Miss Liffey—When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of the filly, which was resuming, rider M. Cahill stated that in his view his mount was never comfortable on today's heavy 10 track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination of the filly revealed no abnormalities

Cumberland Range—Trainer Mr M. Miladinovic was fined the sum of \$50 under LR35 for the late declaration of Ms C. Ings as the rider of the gelding.

Ming—Slow to begin.

Manatassee—Slow to begin.

Perizada—Shortly after the start had to be restrained from the heels of *McLennan* (App. R. Hunt) which shifted in slightly when not clear. App. R. Hunt was told to exercise more care.

RACE 8: KENO BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP 1200M

Tides Of Fortune—Passing the 1100 metres improved into doubtful room between *Hapizen* and *Darbalara* and had to be restrained soon after when *Hapizen* shifted out marginally.

Darbalara—Slow to begin. Passing the 1100 metres had to be checked when taken out across the heels of *Lindendoom* when carried out by *Tides of Fortune* (App. B. McDougall) which shifted out after improving into doubtful room between *Darbalara* and *Hapizen*, which shifted out slightly when losing ground. In all the circumstances App. McDougall was reprimanded under AR137 (a) and warned against the practice of attempting to improve into positions when there was not sufficient room to do so.

Oakwood Lady—Rider M. Cahill was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race.
